Report Brief on Compliance to Chronic Homeless Data Completion

CPC completed a report monitoring the completion rate of data necessary to derive the Chronic Homeless status for active clients as of January 31, 2017. The Chronic Homeless status is automatically calculated by the HMIS from responses to several different questions regarding disabling condition, length of homelessness and previous entries into emergency or transitional shelters. Failure to complete each of these question will result in a "Missing" response under Chronic Homeless status. It is imperative that agencies achieve a 100% response rate for Chronic Homeless status due to its priority in the Coordinated Entry System and HUD program funding.

Attached to this memo is a listing by agency and program (and agency overall) of the number and rate of Missing values under chronic homeless status. Agencies should use this list to revise data among its active clients to achieve a 100% response rate.

The attachment also provides a summary of the Missing Rate by type of program. As expected, Outreach programs have the highest rate of cases (65%) that have a Missing response under chronic homelessness. Permanent Supportive Housing cases also have a very high Missing responses rate (54%). While ES/TH/RRH have much lower rates (under 20% missing), improvements are still needed to reduce the number of Missing responses.

The HMIS team will be monitoring this data quality issue on a monthly basis and will be providing feedback and recommendation to HPO concerning these needed data quality improvements.
