#### Report Brief on Compliance to Chronic Homeless Data Completion

For the Month of April 2017

The CPC HMIS team completed two analyses after reviewing data completion for the "Chronic Homeless" fields: 1) Analysis of all cases (n=7,024) active during the month of April 2017, and 2) Analysis of new intakes (n=871) during the month of April 2017. The report was completed on April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Key findings include:

#### All Cases active during April 2017

- A total of 25 percent, or 1,787 out of 7,024 adults, contained missing data necessary to calculate the chronic homeless field. This represents a 17% drop from March 2017 and a 95% improvement since the February 2017 report.
- The closure of old outreach cases through the auto-exit function has worked to reduce the number of cases with missing information.
- Comparing missing data by program, Outreach had the highest level with 48%, followed by Permanent Supportive Housing 30%, Transitional Housing 12%, and Emergency Shelter 9% and Rapid Rehousing 6%.
- Homeless Prevention showed a missing rate of 12% (55 cases) with 4 cases reported as chronic homeless. By definition, adults served by homeless prevention programs are not chronically homeless.
- Due to the design of entering outreach information for new HPO contracts, the chronic homeless fields are not entered for outreach cases while they are in "contact only" mode thus calculating the CH data as missing. Interpretation of the missing rate among these cases must take this under consideration.

#### All Cases Entered during April, 2017

- A total of 18 percent, or 161 out of 871, contained missing data necessary to calculate the chronic homeless field.
- Comparing missing data by program, Outreach had the highest level with 37%, while all the other programs had missing rates under 10%.
- Over 95% of the missing data (153 out of 161) were found in Outreach programs
- A comparison by Island shows that Oahu had the highest rate of missing data (23%) followed by Hawaii (9%), Maui (5%) and Kauai (0%).
- Due to the design of entering outreach information for new HPO contracts, the chronic homeless fields are not entered for outreach cases while they are in "contact only" mode thus calculating the CH data as missing. Interpretation of the missing rate among these cases must take this under consideration.
