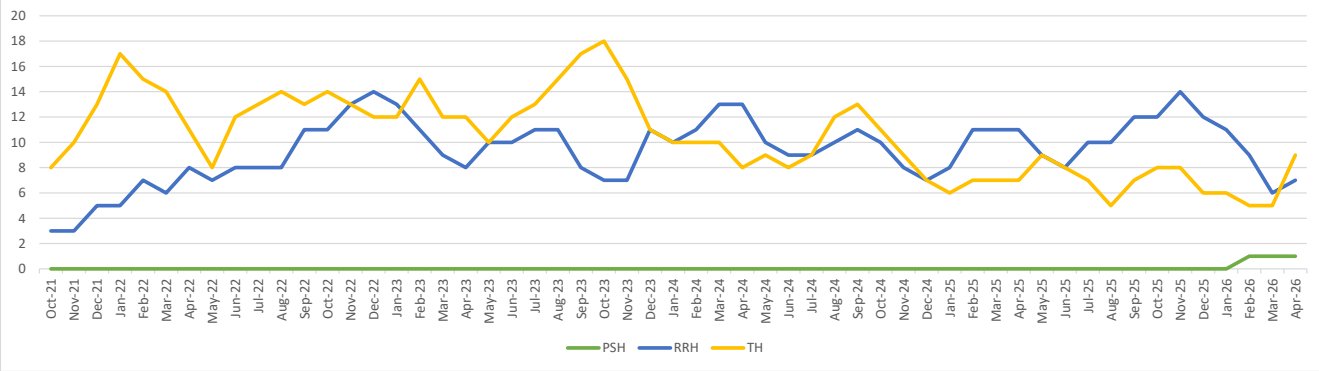
BNL - BTG Active Families from Section 1.1
