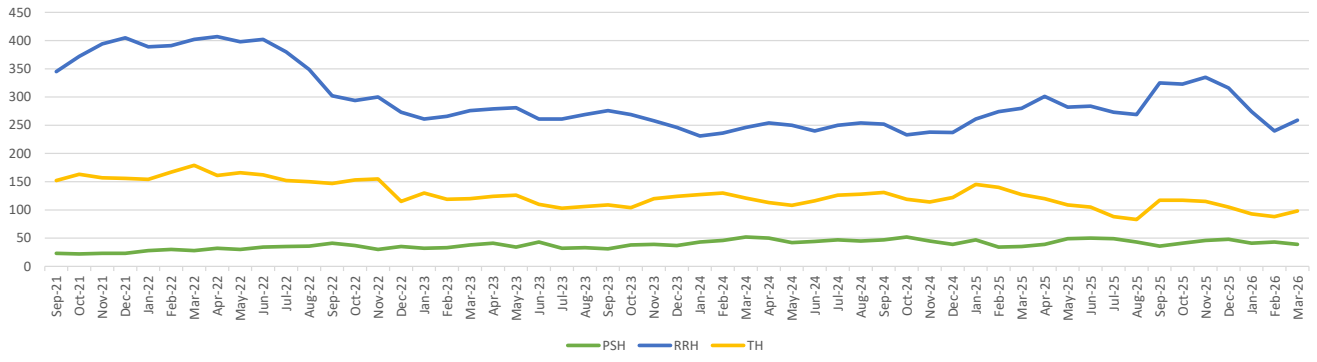

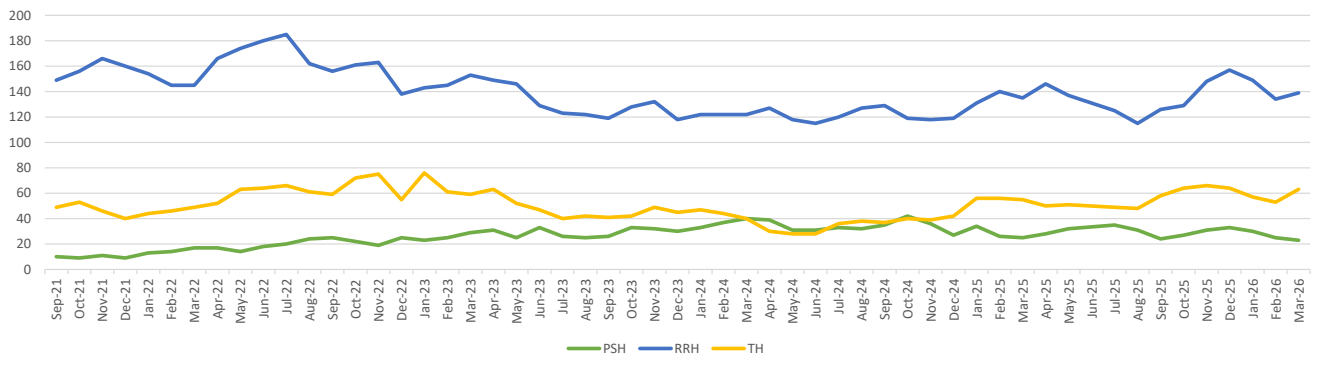

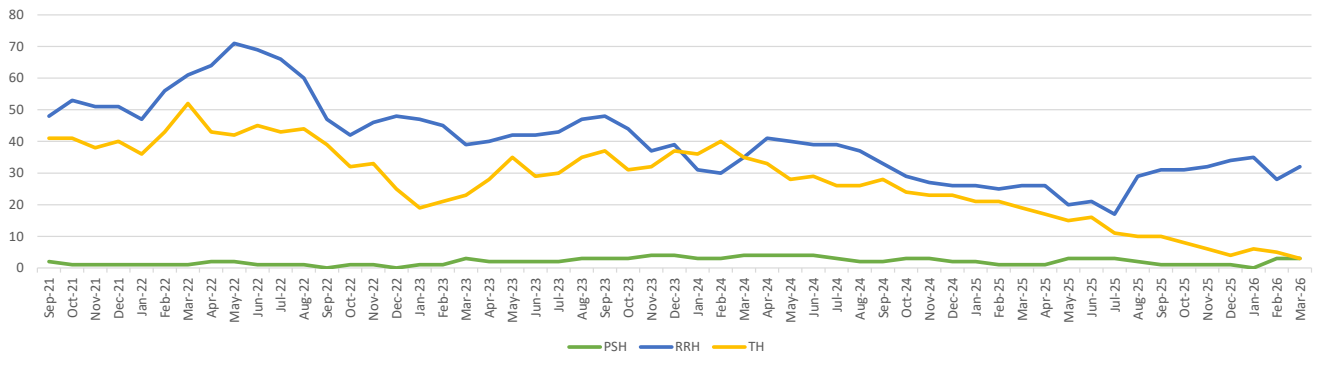
BNL - BTG Active Singles from Section 1.1
