

**Report Brief**  
**Compliance to Chronic Homeless Data Completion**  
 For the Month of April 2018

The CPC HMIS team completed an analysis reviewing data completion for the “Chronic Homeless” fields for new adult intakes (n=1,091) during April 2018. Key findings of the report include:

All Cases Entered during April 2018:

- A total of 91 out of 1,091 (8%) reported MISSING DATA (including data not collected or client refused) under the Chronic homeless field, a 1-percentage point decrease compared to March 2018 (83 records missing data out of 949 records); a significant decrease compared to April 2017 missing data (19%).
- 56 of the 91 intakes (62%) with missing data were new OUTREACH intakes, showing a significant improvement with a 13-percentage point decrease compared to March 2018.
- Of Oahu’s 773 intakes, 75 (10%) lacked data for the chronic homeless calculated field.
- Missing data was reported for the chronic homeless field for Maui (14 cases), Hawaii (1 case); and Kauai (1 case).

All Cases Active during April 2018:

- A total of 11%, or 912 out of 8,107 adults, contained missing data necessary to calculate the chronic homeless field. This is the same rate as March 2018, a 19-percentage point decrease compared to the 30% rate of missing data in the April 2017 report.
- Comparing missing data by program type, Outreach had the highest level with 28%, followed by Homeless Prevention (8%), Services Only (7%), Permanent Supportive Housing and Transitional Housing (7%), Emergency Shelter and Rapid Rehousing (4%).
- Homeless Prevention’s data show a missing rate of 8% (65 cases) and 1 case reported as chronically homeless. Adults served by homeless prevention programs should not be chronically homeless.
- Due to the design of entering street outreach information into the HMIS, the chronic homeless fields are not entered for outreach cases until they become “engaged”, this in turn contributes to high missing CH rates. Interpretation of the missing rate among these cases must take this into consideration.

The following table summarizes the MISSING status of all active ADULT cases (n=8,107) in the system during the month of April 2018 by Program Type. Outreach records (554) represent approximately 61% of all cases with missing data followed by Permanent Housing (94), which represents approximately 6%. Missing rates > 10% are marked in RED.
