

**Report Brief**  
**Compliance to Chronic Homeless Data Completion**  
 For the Month of November 2018

The CPC HMIS team completed an analysis reviewing data completion for the “Chronic Homeless” fields for new adult intakes (n=820) during November 2018. Key findings of the report include:

All Cases Entered during November 2018:

- A total of 53 out of 820 (6%) reported MISSING DATA (including data not collected or client refused) under the Chronic homeless field, a 3-percentage point decrease compared to October. This represents a sustained improvement in 2018, as well as a significant decrease compared to 2017 with a 19% missing data rate from April.
- Most of the intakes with missing data were new Outreach intakes - 36 of the 172 outreach intakes (21%).
- Of Oahu’s 524 intakes, 35 (7%) lacked data for the chronic homeless field. Neighbor islands in aggregate accounted for 296 intakes, 18 (9%) lacked data for the chronic homeless field.
- Missing data was reported for the chronic homeless field for Hawaii (1), Maui (15); Kauai (2).

All Cases active as of November 30, 2018:

- A total of 8%, or 483 out of 6,422 adults, were missing the data necessary to calculate the chronic homeless field.
- Comparing missing data by program type, Outreach had the highest level with 22%, followed by Homeless Prevention, Permanent Supportive Housing, and Services Only (5%), then Transitional Housing, Emergency Shelter and Rapid Rehousing (3%).
- Homeless Prevention’s data show a missing rate of 5% (36 cases) and 2 cases reported as chronically homeless. Adults served by homeless prevention programs should not be chronically homeless.
- Due to the design of entering street outreach information into the HMIS, the chronic homeless fields are not entered for outreach cases until they become “engaged”, this in turn contributes to high missing CH rates. Interpretation of the missing rate among these cases must take this into consideration.

The following table summarizes the MISSING data status of ALL active ADULT cases (n=6,422) in the system as of November 30, 2018 by Program Type. Missing street outreach records (290) represented approximately 60% of all cases with missing data followed by Permanent Housing (62), which represented approximately 13%. Missing rates > 10% are marked in RED.
