# Summary of Key Points Analysis of Exit Destinations by County, Program Type, and Organization Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap

For January 2021

#### Ka Mana O Na Helu, HMIS Administration

The HMIS administrative team completed analysis of client exit destinations from HMIS Bridging the Gap program discharge records for the month of January 2021 (n = 291). This analysis presents findings by county, over program type, and by org/program.

The summary tables show the total exits by destination category, along with permanent housing (PH) exit rates. The analysis also includes the total number of exits with unknown exit destination type along with the corresponding exit rates.

Key findings of the monthly reporting include:

- In aggregate, the PH exit rate for January was 60%, with 176 of 291 exits leaving to PH destinations, a slight decrease compared to December 2020 (61%), and two percentage points lower than BTG's average PH exit rate (62%) over the last 12 months.
- Of the 176 exits to PH, Homeless Prevention programs exited 111 clients to PH (63%), Rapid Rehousing programs exited 29 clients to PH (16%), Emergency Shelter (ES) exited 19 clients to PH (11%), Street Outreach programs exited 15 clients to PH (9%), and Permanent Supportive Housing exited 2 clients to PH (1%).
- January PH exit rates descending by county were Hawaii (70%), Maui (56%), and Kauai (52%).
- The PH exit rate was 100% for Homeless Prevention programs in January and 97% for Rapid Rehousing programs; the same rate for HP and an increase for RRH, compared to December. Due to the inherent nature of these programs, one would expect that these PH exit rates would be near 100%.
- The missing exit data rate for January was 18%, an increase compared to December (16%).
- Hawaii and Kauai had 14 exits to unknown locations in January, and Maui had 24 exits to unknown destinations.




