Summary of Key Points Analysis of Exit Destinations by County, Program Type, and Organization Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap

For March 2021

The HMIS administrative team completed analysis of client exit destinations from HMIS Bridging the Gap program discharge records for the month of March 2021 (n = 232). This analysis presents findings by county, over program type, and by org/program.

The summary tables show the total exits by destination category, along with permanent housing (PH) exit rates. The analysis also includes the total number of exits with unknown exit destination type along with the corresponding exit rates. Exits for Services Only programs are no longer included in this report as of February 2021.

Key findings of the monthly reporting include:

- In aggregate, the PH exit rate for March was 69%, with 161 of 232 exits leaving to PH destinations, an increase compared to February (65%).
- Of the 161 exits to PH, Homeless Prevention programs exited 74 clients to PH (46%), Rapid Rehousing programs exited 51 clients to PH (32%), Emergency Shelter (ES) exited 27 clients to PH (17%), Street Outreach programs exited 7 clients to PH (4%), and Transitional Housing exited 2 clients to PH (1%).
- March PH exit rates descending by county were Kauai (88%), Hawaii (71%), and Maui (61%).
- The PH exit rate was 100% for Homeless Prevention programs in March and 93% for Rapid Rehousing programs; the same rate for HP and a slight decrease for RRH, compared to February. Due to the inherent nature of these programs, one would expect that these PH exit rates would be near 100%.
- The missing exit data rate for March was 6%, a slight decrease compared to February (7%).
- Maui had 9 exits to unknown locations in March, Hawaii had 3 and Kauai had 2 exits to unknown destinations.




