# Summary of Key Points Analysis of Exit Destinations by County, Program Type, and Organization Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap

For April 2021

### Ka Mana O Na Helu, HMIS Administration

The HMIS administrative team completed analysis of client exit destinations from HMIS Bridging the Gap program discharge records for the month of April 2021 (n = 279). This analysis presents findings by county, over program type, and by org/program.

The summary tables show the total exits by destination category, along with permanent housing (PH) exit rates. The analysis also includes the total number of exits with unknown exit destination type along with the corresponding exit rates. Exits for Services Only programs are no longer included in this report as of February 2021.

Key findings of the monthly reporting include:

- In aggregate, the PH exit rate for April was 55%, with 153 of 279 exits leaving to PH destinations, a decrease compared to March (69%).
- Of the 153 exits to PH, Emergency Shelter (ES) exited 59 clients to PH (39%), Homeless Prevention programs exited 29 clients to PH (19%), Rapid Re-housing programs exited 23 clients to PH (15%), Street Outreach programs exited 22 clients to PH (14%), Transitional and Permanent Support Housing each exited 10 clients to PH (7% each).
- April PH exit rates descending by county were Maui (60%), Kauai (54%), and Hawaii (48%).
- The PH exit rate was 100% for Homeless Prevention programs in April and 96% for Rapid Re-housing programs; the same rate for HP and an increase for RRH, compared to March. Due to the inherent nature of these programs, one would expect that these PH exit rates would be near 100%.
- The missing exit data rate for April was 16%, a significant increase compared to March (6%). This includes more "auto exits" than in recent months, which contributed to the high missing exit data rate (e.g. there were 51 auto exits in April compared to 14 auto exits in March).
- Kauai had 25 exits to unknown locations in April, Maui had 17 and Hawaii had 4 exits to unknown destinations.




