# Summary of Key Points Analysis of Exit Destinations by County, Program Type, and Organization Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap

For June 2021

### Ka Mana O Na Helu, HMIS Administration

The HMIS administrative team completed analysis of client exit destinations from HMIS Bridging the Gap program discharge records for the month of June 2021 (n = 375). This analysis presents findings by county, over program type, and by org/program.

The summary tables show the total exits by destination category, along with permanent housing (PH) exit rates. The analysis also includes the total number of exits with unknown exit destination type along with the corresponding exit rates. Exits for Services Only programs are no longer included in this report as of February 2021.

Key findings of the monthly reporting include:

- In aggregate, the PH exit rate for June was 55%, with 205 of 375 exits leaving to PH destinations, an increase compared to May (52%).
- Of the 205 exits to PH, Homeless Prevention programs exited 110 clients to PH (54%), Rapid Rehousing programs exited 43 clients to PH (21%), Emergency Shelter (ES) exited 35 clients to PH (17%), Street Outreach exited 12 clients to PH (6%), Permanent Supportive Housing exited 4 clients to PH (2%), and Transitional Housing (TH) exited 1 client to PH.
- June PH exit rates descending by county were Hawaii (63%), Maui (57%), and Kauai (40%).
- The PH exit rate was 96% for Homeless Prevention and 84% for Rapid Re-housing programs in June, decreases compared to May (100% for both program types). Due to the inherent nature of these programs, one would expect that these PH exit rates would be near 100%.
- The missing exit data rate for June was 16%, a decrease compared to May (22%). "Auto exits" contributed to the high missing exit data rate (53 auto exits in June).
- Kauai had 50 exits to unknown locations in June, Maui had 8, and Hawaii had 3 exits to unknown destinations.




