# Summary of Key Points Analysis of Exit Destinations by County, Program Type, and Organization

For July 2018

The HMIS admin team completed analysis of client exit destinations from HMIS program discharge records for the month of July 2018 (n = 1,238). The analysis presents findings by county, over program type, and by org/program.

The summary tables show the total exits by destination category, along with permanent housing exit rates. Analysis also includes the total number of exits with unknown exit destination type along with the corresponding exit rates.

Key findings of the monthly reporting include:

- In aggregate, the PH exit rate for July was 53% with 659 of 1,238 exits leaving to PH destinations, continuing to reflect improvements since July 2017 (33%).
- Of the 659 PH exits, Rapid Re-Housing programs exited 172 clients to PH (26%), Homeless Prevention programs exited 156 clients to PH (24%), and Emergency Shelter programs exited 180 clients to PH (27%).
- Street Outreach and Emergency Shelter project types should not be evaluated solely on exits to PH. Often, placements into institutional settings, transitional shelters, or residential projects are positive outcomes for these project types.
- July PH rates descending by county were Hawaii (75%), Maui (52%), Oahu (50%), and Kauai (41%).
- Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing projects had the highest PH exit rates (98% and 82% respectively). Due to the inherent nature of these programs, however, one would expect that these rates be nearly 100%.
- The missing exit data rate jumped from 12% in June to 16% in July (194 clients with unknown exits). The missing exit data rate, first calculated in July 2017 was 34%.
- Oahu and Maui had the greatest proportion of exits to unknown locations in July, with 18% (153 exits) for Oahu and 17% (34 exits) for Maui. Usually ES or Outreach projects represent the vast majority of these exits, but Oahu's Rapid Re-housing and Transitional Housing programs had an increase in exits with missing destinations.
- Oahu Emergency Shelter (27%) and Services Only programs (31%) had the highest rates of missing exit data in July.


