Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap

For August 2020

The HMIS administrative team completed analysis of client exit destinations from HMIS Bridging the Gap program discharge records for the month of August 2020 (n = 221). This analysis presents findings by county, over program type, and by org/program.

The summary tables show the total exits by destination category, along with permanent housing (PH) exit rates. The analysis also includes the total number of exits with unknown exit destination type along with the corresponding exit rates.

Key findings of the monthly reporting include:

- In aggregate, the PH exit rate for August was 60%, with 132 of 221 exits leaving to PH destinations, a decrease compared to July 2020 (61%), but above BTG’s average PH exit rate (57%) over the last 12 months.
- Of the 132 exits to PH, Homeless Prevention programs exited 44 clients to PH (33%), Rapid Re-housing programs exited 39 clients to PH (30%), Emergency Shelter (ES) exited 25 clients to PH (19%), and both Transitional Housing and Street Outreach programs exited 12 clients each to PH (9%).
- August PH exit rates descending by county were Kauai (66%), Maui (58%), and Hawaii (58%).
- The PH exit rate was 100% for Homeless Prevention programs in August and 98% for Rapid Re-housing programs; this is a two-percentage point decrease for Rapid Re-Housing programs compared to July. The average PH rates for 2019 were 92% for Homeless Prevention and 84% for Rapid Re-housing programs. Due to the inherent nature of these programs, one would expect that these PH exit rates be near 100%.
- The missing exit data rate for August was 20%, a significant increase compared the previous 7 months, which averaged 8%.
- Maui had the greatest number of exits to unknown locations in August (28 exits) followed by Kauai, with 13 exits to unknown locations. Hawaii had four exits without exit destinations.

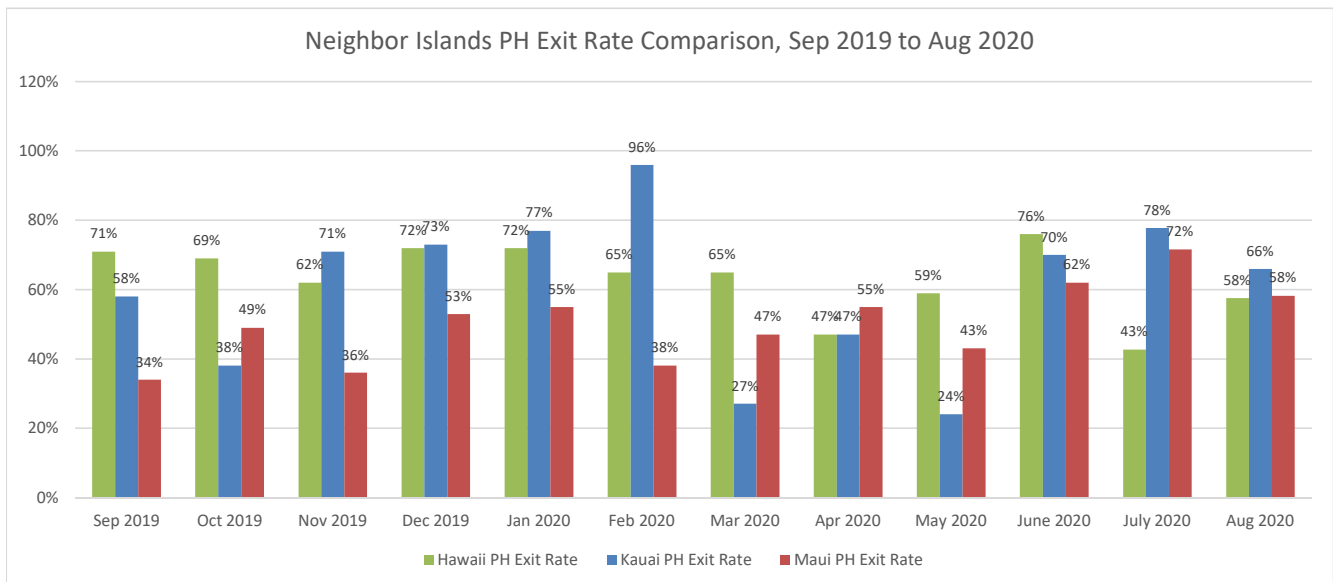

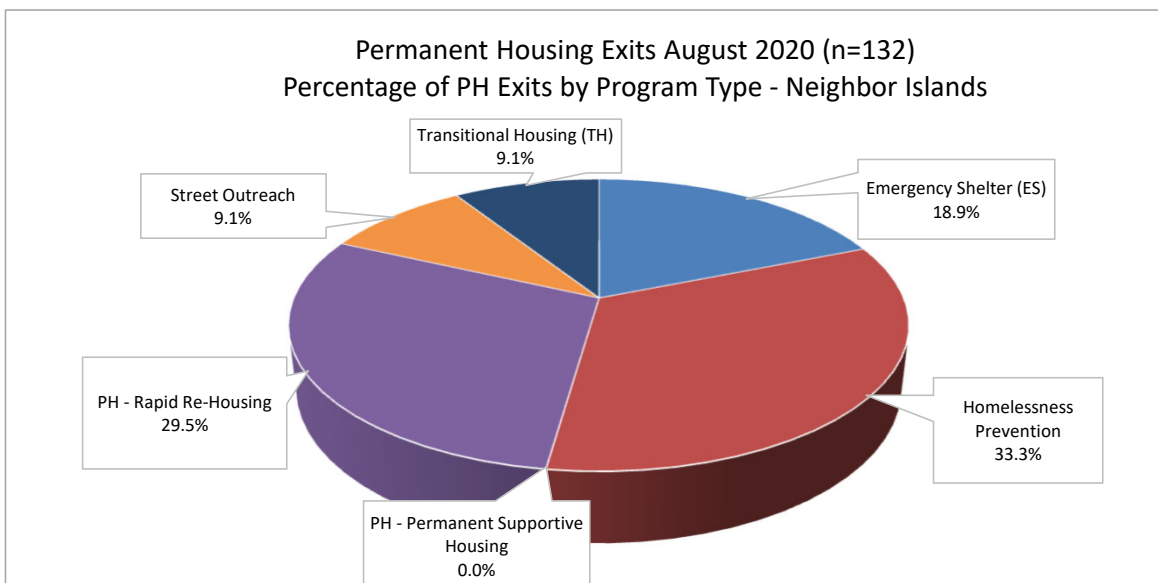
