Summary of Key Points Analysis of Exit Destinations by County, Program Type, and Organization Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap

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For December 2020

The HMIS administrative team completed analysis of client exit destinations from HMIS Bridging the Gap program discharge records for the month of December 2020 (n = 275). This analysis presents findings by county, over program type, and by org/program.

The summary tables show the total exits by destination category, along with permanent housing (PH) exit rates. The analysis also includes the total number of exits with unknown exit destination type along with the corresponding exit rates.

Key findings of the monthly reporting include:

- In aggregate, the PH exit rate for December was 61%, with 168 of 275 exits leaving to PH destinations, a decrease compared to November 2020 (66%), and one percentage point lower than BTG's average PH exit rate (62%) over the last 12 months.
- Of the 168 exits to PH, Homeless Prevention programs exited 92 clients to PH (55%), Emergency Shelter (ES) exited 25 clients to PH (15%), Rapid Re-housing programs exited 23 clients to PH (14%), Transitional Housing exited 12 clients (7%), Street Outreach programs exited 11 clients to PH (7%), and Permanent Supportive Housing exited 5 clients to PH (3%).
- December PH exit rates descending by county were Maui (66%), Hawaii (65%), and Kauai (31%).
- The PH exit rate was 100% for Homeless Prevention programs in December and 96% for Rapid Rehousing programs; the same rate for HP and an increase for RRH, compared to November. Due to the inherent nature of these programs, one would expect that these PH exit rates would be near 100%.
- The missing exit data rate for December was 16%, an increase compared to October (9%).
- Maui and Hawaii had 18 exits to unknown locations in December, and Kauai had 8 exits to unknown destinations.


