Compliance to Chronic Homeless Data Completion

For the Month of May 2017

The CPC HMIS team completed an analysis reviewing data completion for the "Chronic Homeless" fields for new adult intakes (n=1,203) during May 2017. Key findings include:

All Cases Entered during May 2017:

- A total of 244 out of 1,203 (20%) reported MISSING DATA under the Chronic homeless field
- 235 of the 244 intakes (95%) with missing data were new OUTREACH intakes
- Both Hawaii and Kauai reported no missing data (0%) for the chronic homeless field
- Maui had 12 out of 218 cases (6%) with missing data for the chronic homeless field
- Oahu reported 232 out of 832 (28%) with missing data for the chronic homeless field
- Three Outreach organizations on Oahu accounted for 223 of the 235 cases (95%) with missing data including the CHOW Project (33 missing cases), Kalihi Palama Health Center (149 missing cases) and Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center (41 missing cases).
- A review of the missing cases does not reveal a specific staff member for these cases since the assessment name and user ID are also missing for these cases.

All Cases active during May 2017:

- A total of 21%, or 1,535 out of 7,152 adults, contained missing data necessary to calculate the chronic homeless field. This represents a 4% drop compared to April 2017 and a 28% overall decline since the January 2017 report.
- The closure of old outreach cases through the auto-exit functionality has worked to reduce the number of cases with missing information.
- Comparing missing data by program, Outreach had the highest level with 45%, followed by Permanent Supportive Housing 23%, Transitional Housing 9%, Emergency Shelter 6%, and Rapid Rehousing 5%.
- Homeless Prevention showed a missing rate of 10% (49 cases) with 5 cases reported as chronically homeless. By definition, adults served by homeless prevention programs are not chronically homeless.
- Due to the design of entering street outreach information into the HMIS, the chronic homeless fields are not entered for outreach cases until they become "engaged", this in turn contributes to high missing CH rates. Interpretation of the missing rate among these cases must take this under consideration.

The following table summarizes the MISSING status of all active ADULT cases (n=7,152) in the system during the month of May 2017 by Program Type. Outreach records represent approximately 63% of all cases with missing data followed by PSH, which represents approximately 20%.
