Re: November 2016 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to the two Continuums are the November 2016 HMIS monitoring reports. These reports use data extracted from the HMIS as of the 15th of December. The reports follow the format of previous monthly reports and include some additional analysis including veteran census counts, and active outreach counts. Highlights include:

1. Intake and Exit Timeliness decreased to 5.61 and 6.74 days respectively, down from October averages of 9.88 and 8.38 days. There appears to be a continued problem with agencies not entering intakes and exits until the end of the month since a mid-month check revealed a much lower timeliness number. The goal continues to be 3 days or fewer. Eighteen (18) programs registered a timeliness average of 10 days or greater for both intake and exit.
2. Census numbers showed continued problems with a small group of programs that have census numbers more than 20% above or below their HIC count. The CoC agencies need to review their HIC count and make appropriate adjustments.
3. The VA VASH program showed no progress (intake or discharge entry) during the past month.
4. The total Sheltered Homeless census as of November 30th as defined by HUD totaled 3,606 Statewide (2,774 Oahu and 832 BOS). This is nearly identical to the PIT 2016 sheltered count of 3,613. One shelter on the Big Island has not completed entering their persons, which undercounts the BOS shelter count by approximately 40 persons.
5. The number of persons active in outreach totaled 5,368 on Oahu and 2,747 on the Neighbor Islands for a Statewide total of 8,115. This total includes an unknown number of persons who are not homeless, but served through outreach, and persons that are duplicated, receiving services from two or more Outreach providers. In addition, it is unclear what number of outreach clients are actively receiving services.
6. An additional review of Statewide discharges from July through November revealed a total of 21 persons who were recorded as deceased, including 4 persons during the month of November.

Recommendations:

- 1) All agencies need to report to the State of Hawaii their current HIC bed units and actual census on December 31st, 2016 to correct any variances due to misinformation.
- 2) New contracts for funding (HUD and HPO) should include performance measures tracking timeliness to entry for intakes and discharges.
- 3) Additional efforts are needed to achieve progress on HMIS compliance by the VA and Hawaii Public Housing Authority for VASH vouchers.
- 4) The Outreach section of the database should be cleaned (everything exited except PIT clients) as of January 31st. Any outreach program that is serving "non-homeless" persons should have a separate Homeless Prevention or Services Only program setup in the HMIS so these totals do not mix with the homeless census.
- 5) Since Length of Stay averages at Transitional Shelters continue to be over 200 days, it is important for the State of Hawaii and the Continuums to better strategize about how to work towards a goal of 90 days through the conversion of a portion (50% or more) of units of current transitional capacity.
