Re: September 2016 HMIS Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to the two Continuums are the September 2016 HMIS monitoring reports. These reports use data extracted from the HMIS as of the 15th of October or later. The reports follow the format of previous monthly reports. Highlights include:

1. HI-501 (Oahu) saw improvements in keeping HMIS program census counts up-to-date. HI-500 (BOS) census numbers still revealed too many programs with census counts above maximum bed count reflecting either a failure to complete discharge forms or other HMIS compliance problems.
2. End of month census for HI-501 (Oahu) fell slightly from 2,810 in August to 2,786 in September. HUD-500 (BOS) census counts fell significantly from 836 to 746. End of month HMIS PSH counts reported 970 for Oahu and 247 for the Balance of State. Due to non-compliance by the Department of Veterans Affairs, the number of VASH PSH units reported in the HMIS totals underestimate the actual totals.
3. Timeliness of intake and discharge entry continued to show improvements from a statewide average of 11 days for intakes and exits during the July-August period to 7 days during the Aug-September period. Several agency programs continue to show a very high number of days (20 or more) between intake or discharge and HMIS data entry.
4. Length of stay reports showed a system-wide average of 277 days with a total 2,692 exits during August and September. The HMIS admin team continues to enter old discharge data on clients in several programs including the four (4) VASH programs.

The HMIS Admin team expects monthly data to gradually improve and reflect more accurate census counts, timeliness and length of stay data beginning January 1st when all legacy data should be cleaned and providers are expected to show greater consistency with HMIS data compliance.

Report Definitions and Abbreviation Explanations

Header Definitions:

HIC Beds: Total bed capacity as listed on the Housing Inventory Chart (HIC) submitted to HUD in the most recent NOFA funding application.

Census on Sep 30th: Report calculation totaling the number of active enrollments in program in the system on September 30th (last day of report month).

% HIC Beds: Represents the percent of beds filled as on the census day. The census number divided by the reported maximum bed number. Numbers greater than 100% represent overcapacity or counts that may contain errors (missing discharges).

Technical Openings: Represents the number of beds open/unused based on comparison of the HIC bed count and the census bed count. May not necessarily represent the actual beds available due to variation in family members per unit, off-line units and other circumstances. Provide a general comparison that can highlight potential issues. If filled or overfilled, value is set to zero.

NL – Not Listed. Either on HIC or in CaseWorthy program listing

NA – Not Applicable

SP – Special Populations that are confidential and not currently reported on CaseWorthy reports. Populations included Domestic Violence, AIDS/HIV and Youth.
