Re: March 2017 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the March 2017 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1) End of Month Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-6)

- Small Statewide increase in active emergency shelter census (1,411 to 1,439) with virtually no change in persons residing in transitional shelter census (1,929 to 1,930).
- The number of persons in Permanent Supportive Housing (Statewide) rose 6% to 1,347.
- Active persons on Oahu defined as sheltered homeless (ES/TH) totaled 2,604, a 29 person drop from February, while Neighbor Islands sheltered homelessness rose from 707 to 765.
- 2) End of Month Census report by Island (page 1)
 - Oahu had the most active HMIS cases with 6,431 followed by Maui (1,616) then Hawaii (807) and Kauai (400).
 - Oahu had the most active HMIS veteran cases with 678 followed by Maui (339) then Hawaii (88) and Kauai (29). Totals do not include an unknown number of active VASH PSH cases.
 - Approximately 4,500 outreach cases were auto-exited by the system. These exits are reflected in different months based on last encounter dates.
- 3) Consent report for intakes during March 2017 (pp. 11-14)
 - Oahu had the lowest level of HMIS shared consent with 69% overall compared to Maui (83%), Hawaii (83%) and Kauai (89%). Overall, the Statewide level for intakes was 73%.
 - Several agencies achieved consent rates over 90% including Chow Project 100%, Mental Health Kokua 100%, Weinberg Village Waimanalo 100%, Women in Need 100%, Steadfast 100%, Salvation Army ATS 100%, HOPE Services Hawaii 99%, Family Promise 95%, and KHAKO 94%.
 - 20 programs had consent rates of 50% or lower among new March intakes.
- 4) Length of Stay by agency and program for exits during March 2017 (pp. 7-10)
 - The average LOS for all 1,914 exits during March was 245 days. Exits from outreach programs represented a total of 1,125, or 59% of all exits.
 - Among Emergency Shelters, Hawaii county facilities registered the longest LOS at 116 days, followed by Oahu at 100 days, Maui at 31 days and Kauai at 15 days.
 - Among Transitional Shelters, Oahu facilities registered the longest LOS at 285 days, followed by Kauai at 202 days, Hawaii at 145 days, and Maui at 92 days.
- 5) Timeliness (intake and exits) during March 2017 (pp. 15-19)
 - Intake timeliness averaged 4.08 days, representing a slight increase from 3.96 days during February.
 - Exit data entry timeliness averaged 4.13, a small decrease from 4.27 days in February. Exit timeliness is greatly impacted by large numbers of auto-exits which automatically have an exit timeliness of 0.00 days. It is estimated that exit timeliness without the auto exits would exceed 6 days.
