Re: December 2016 HMIS Monitoring Reports

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Attached for your review and dissemination to the Continuum agencies are the December 2016 HMIS monitoring reports. These reports use data extracted from the HMIS as of the 15<sup>th</sup> of January. The reports follow the format of previous monthly reports. An additional report of the percentage of clients recorded as giving consent to HMIS sharing is included this month. Highlights include:

1. Intake and Exit Timeliness decreased to 5.31 and 6.43 days respectively. The prior month's numbers are revised each month due to continuous updating by some programs entering old or revised intakes and discharges. See table below for averages as of data entry through 1/15/17.

2. Census numbers include the new Kakaako Family Assessment program which was not previously listed in the prior reports. A significant drop in the Emergency Shelter census for BOS occurred, dropping from 412 to 333. Much of this drop may be attributed to more accurate HMIS census counts for several BOS ES programs. The statewide shelter census dropped slightly from 3,606 to 3,513. However, these HMIS numbers do not include DV shelters – which are considered homeless facilities and include continued unknown errors in some programs.
3. The VA VASH program occupancy and vacancy has been taken off the charts due to the lack of accurate information and an unwillingness to enter this data into the HMIS. National data for Hawaii shows 188 vacancies out of 677 total vouchers (28% vacancy rate) through September 30<sup>th</sup>. Most of the drop in PH census from Nov to Dec is related to this report change.
4. The number of persons active in Street Outreach totaled 5,467 on Oahu and 2,817 on the Neighbor Islands for a Statewide total of 8,284. This total includes an unknown number of persons who are not homeless, but served through outreach, and persons duplicated, receiving service from two (2) or more Outreach providers. In addition, it is unclear what number of outreach clients are actively receiving services.
5. A review of the Consent percentage of all active records showed a 52% overall consent rate (selection of "Yes" value). Large variation is present between agencies and programs within agencies. The attached report highlights in red rates below 70%, a working threshold.
