Re: May 2021 HMIS Monitoring Reports (Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap)

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the May 2021 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1. End of month, May 2021 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-5)
 - The Neighbor Island census for emergency shelter (ES) and transitional housing (TH) programs decreased in May 2021 (611), compared to April (555), with an increase in both ES and TH programs.
 - The total “vacant beds” compared to the HIC bed capacity was 208 (ES and TH) and 42 (permanent supportive housing – PSH). This is a decrease compared to last month. HIC openings can also vary depending on differences in household size.
 - 31 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
 - Active outreach clients totaled 588, an increase compared to April (549 clients).
2. Consent report for May 2021 (pp. 6-11)
 - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rate for Neighbor Islands was 100%, the same rate as March and April.
 - By Name List consent to share data rate as of the 5/31/21, BNL cut was 99% for the CoC, the same rate as March and April.
 - For adult program intakes entered in May 2021 (n=298), the Neighbor Islands consent to share data rate was 98%, one percentage point lower than in April.
 - For May intakes, 3 programs had consent rate below 80%. These are noted in red on page 8.
3. Length of stay (LOS) by agency and program for clients exiting during May 2021 (pp. 12-14)
 - The average LOS over all programs was 205 days (representing 250 exits), an increase compared to April (170 days); May’s LOS was higher than the 12-month average for Neighbors Islands LOS (149 days) from June 2020 – May 2021.
 - This month, excluding PSH, the average LOS was 143 days.
 - Homeless Prevention and Services Only/Outreach programs’ LOS were the shortest (129 and 138 days). Permanent Supporting Housing and Transitional Housing programs’ LOS were the longest (847 and 187 days).
 - By County, Maui (222) averaged the longest LOS, followed by Hawaii (198 days), and Kauai (197 days).
 - Emergency shelter average LOS ranged from 18 days on Kauai to 180 days on Maui.
 - Transitional housing average LOS was 187 days on Kauai; no TH exits from other counties.
4. Timeliness (entries and exits) during May 2021 (pp. 15-18)
 - Intake timeliness decreased to 1.65 average days, from 2.02 average days in April.
 - 14 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter intakes.
 - Exit timeliness decreased to 0.87 average days, compared to 1.72 average days in April.
 - 11 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.

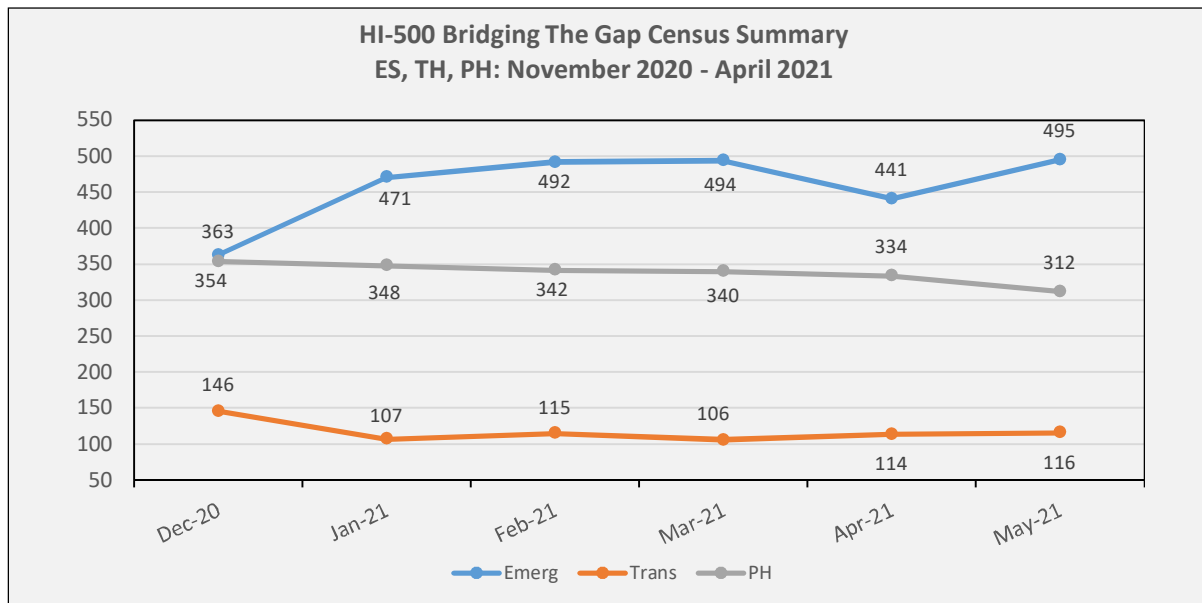

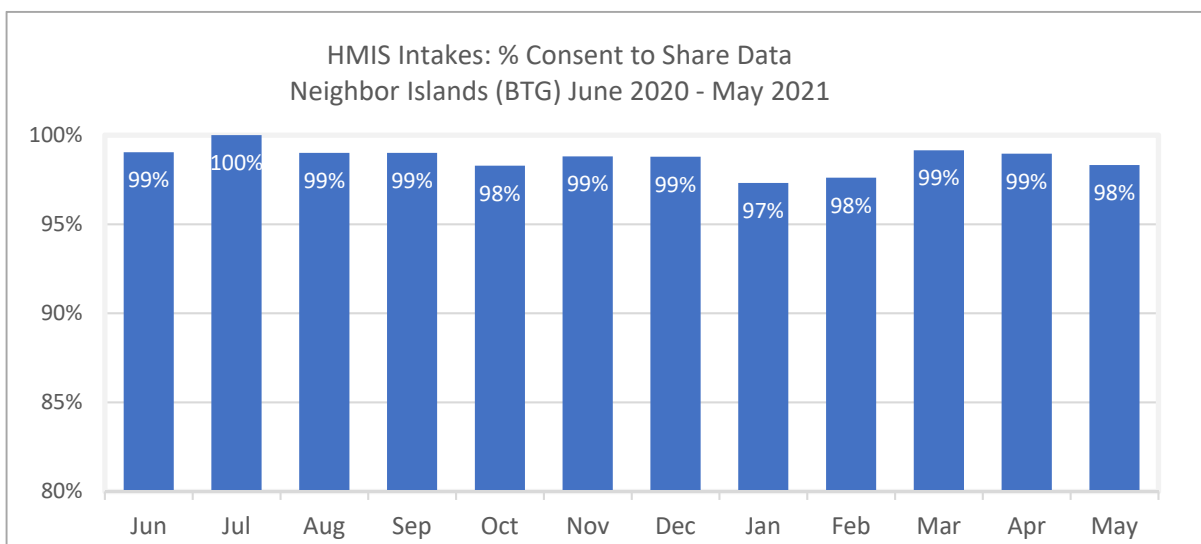
