Re: June 2021 HMIS Monitoring Reports (Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap)

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the June 2021 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1. End of month, June 2021 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-5)

- The Neighbor Island census for emergency shelter (ES) and transitional housing (TH) programs increased in June 2021 (681), compared to May (611), with an increase in ES, while TH programs remained the same.
- The total "vacant beds" compared to the HIC bed capacity was 166 (ES and TH), a decrease compared to last month (208); permanent supportive housing PSH HIC openings increased in June to 51 beds from 42. HIC openings can also vary depending on differences in household size.
- 29 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- Active outreach clients totaled 653, an increase compared to May (588 clients).
- 2. Consent report for June 2021 (pp. 6-11)
  - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rate for Neighbor Islands was 99%, a decrease compared to the past 3 months.
  - By Name List consent to share data rate as of the 7/11/2021, BNL cut was 99% for the CoC, the same rate as the past 3 months.
  - For adult program intakes entered in June 2021 (n=281), the Neighbor Islands consent to share data rate was 96%, a decrease compared to May (98%).
  - For June intakes, 7 programs had consent rate below 80%. These are noted in red on page 8.
- 3. Length of stay (LOS) by agency and program for clients exiting during June 2021 (pp. 12-14)
  - The average LOS over all programs was 157 days (representing 382 exits), a decrease compared to May (205 days); June's LOS was higher than the 12-month average for Neighbors Islands LOS (150 days) from July 2020 – June 2021.
  - This month, excluding PSH, the average LOS was 138 days.
  - Transitional and Emergency Shelter programs' LOS were the shortest (90 and 113 days). Permanent Supporting Housing and Services Only programs' LOS were the longest (1,045 and 192 days).
  - By County, Hawaii (186) averaged the longest LOS, followed by Kauai (142 days), and Maui (139 days).
  - Emergency shelter average LOS ranged from 37 days on Kauai to 146 days on Maui.
  - There was only one Transitional housing exit, which took place on Kauai (LOS was 90 days)
- 4. Timeliness (entries and exits) during June 2021 (pp. 15-18)
  - Intake timeliness increased to 2.38 average days, from 1.65 average days in May.
  - 18 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter intakes.
  - Exit timeliness increased to 1.93 average days, compared to 0.87 average days in May.
  - 9 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.




