Re: October 2017 HMIS Monitoring Reports

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Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the October 2017 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

- 1) End of month, October 2017 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-7)
  - Emergency shelter census increased for both Continuums, while the transitional facilities census decreased for both continuums, resulting in an overall decrease for Oahu from 2,513 to 2,502 and an overall decrease on the Neighbor Islands from 783 to 775.
  - Overall, the HMIS end of month sheltered homeless census (excluding DV shelters) for the State of Hawaii decreased slightly from 3,296 in September to 3,277 in October. The total “vacant beds” as compared to the HIC capacity totaled 533.
  - Statewide active Outreach clients totaled 1,972 including 1,416 on Oahu and 556 on the Neighbor Islands. Outreach clients increased for both CoCs relative to September 2017.
  - 35 programs on Oahu and 23 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- 2) Consent report for program entries during October 2017 (pp. 8-11)
  - The statewide consent to share rate decreased slightly from 86% in September to 84% in October, among the 1,199 new intakes during the month.
  - Consent rates were above 90% for Services Only (97%), Emergency Shelter (96%), Transitional Housing (95%) and Rapid Re-Housing (93%); lower consent rates included Homeless Prevention (86%), Permanent Supportive Housing (89%) and Outreach (72%). Ten programs had consent rates below 80%. These programs are highlighted in RED.
  - The overall rate of consent to share data has increased significantly from 55% in January 2017.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during October 2017 (pp. 12-15)
  - The average LOS for all programs was 283 days (representing 1,149 exits). October's exits include the clients processed as a group from several closed programs, including one large PSH project. Thus, the LOS for the month is skewed significantly compared to the overall average LOS (123 days) reported in September.
  - Oahu (360 days) and Hawaii (122 days) averaged the highest LOS, followed by Kauai (88 days) and Maui (71 days).
  - Emergency shelter LOS ranged from 70 days on Maui to 137 days on Oahu. Transitional shelter LOS ranged from 106 days on Kauai to 678 days on Hawaii.
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during October 2017 (pp. 16-23)
  - Intake timeliness increased to 3.82 average days from 3.02 average days in September.
  - 31 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged 5 or more days to enter intakes, a decrease of 4 programs compared to September.
  - Exit timeliness increased to 4.07 days compared to 1.83 average day in September. This increase may be the result of programs exiting clients in a group after the programs closed.
  - 35 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged 5 or more days to enter exits, an increase of 7 programs compared to September.
