Re: May 2018 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the May 2018 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1) End of month, May 2018 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-8)

- The Statewide census for emergency and transitional programs increased slightly in May 2018 (3,188) compared to April 2018 (3,174), representing an increase in emergency shelter utilization and a decrease in transitional utilization.
- The total "vacant beds" compared to the HIC capacity was 440 (ES and TH) and 244 (PSH).
- 32 programs on Oahu and 23 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- New for May 2018 is the HPO unit utilization analysis (pg. 8). This looks specifically at HPO funded projects and compares actual HH occupancy at the end of the month to unit capacity as stated on proposed facilities descriptions.
- Statewide Active Outreach clients totaled 1,958 including 1,337 on Oahu and 621 on the Neighbor Islands (an increase from April's 1,952 outreach clients). This is due to a decrease for Oahu and an increase for Neighbor Islands.
- 2) Consent report for May 2018 (pp. 9-20)
 - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rates for Neighbor Islands and Oahu programs were 97% and 93% respectively, overall a continued increasing trend (April's rates: 95% and 88%).
 - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of June 1, 2018 was 91% statewide a significant increase compared to the April report; for Oahu Families (77%) and Singles (95%). Neighbor Island family and singles rates ranged from 77% (Kauai family) to 99% (Hawaii family). The increase is in part a result of a new policy to auto-exit names from the list. April's BNL report had 6,931 individuals, while the May report had 2,810.
 - For adult program intakes (n=1,025), the statewide consent to share remained the same as March and April (93%), the highest rate in an upward trend since May 2017(55%).
 - Eight programs had consent rates below 80%. These programs are highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during May 2018 (pp.21-24)
 - The average LOS for all programs was 153 days (representing 1,676 exits), a decrease compared to April (163 days). If the 36 PH programs exits are omitted, the average LOS was 137 days.
 - Overall, emergency shelter and homeless outreach programs' LOS were the shortest (101 and 94 days). PSH and TH program's LOS were longest (876 and 280 days).
 - By County, Oahu (162 days) and Hawaii (152 days) averaged the highest LOS, followed by Kauai (138 days) and Maui (112 days). Of note is that the average includes PH projects, which skewthe statistic.
 - Emergency Shelter LOS ranged from 71 days on Hawaii to 121 days on Maui.
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during May 2018 (pp. 25-29)
 - Intake Timeliness was 3.04 average days, a slight increase compared to 2.92 average days in April. 37 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enterintakes.
 - Exit timeliness decreased to 2.69 average days compared to 4.87 days in April.
 - 36 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.
