Re: June 2018 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the June 2018 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1) End of month, June 2018 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-8)

- The Statewide census for emergency and transitional programs combined decreased in June 2018 (3,140) compared to May 2018 (3,188), representing a decrease for both program types for Oahu and an increase in emergency shelter, yet a decrease in transitional facilities' census for the Neighbor Islands.
- The total "vacant beds" compared to stated HIC capacity was 462 (ES and TH) and 286 (PSH). The large fluctuation in HIC openings over the last month is due to the change to the 2018 HIC reporting numbers.
- 35 programs on Oahu and 21 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red on pp. 4-6.
- Statewide active outreach clients totaled 2,028 including 1,393 on Oahu and 635 on the Neighbor Islands (an increase from May's 1,958 outreach clients). An increase for both CoCs relative to May.
- 2) Consent report for June 2018 (pp. 9-20)
  - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rates for Neighbor Islands and Oahu programs were 96% and 93% respectively; (May's rates were 97% and 93%). (pg. 9)
  - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of July 2, 2018 was 93% statewide an increase compared to the May report; for Oahu Families (81%) and Singles (96%). Neighbor Island family and singles rates ranged from 80% (Kauai family) to 100% (Hawaii family); and 93% to 98% on the singles side. (pp. 10-11).
  - For adult program intakes during June 2018 (n=986), the statewide consent to share rate increased to 95% from 93% in May, the highest the rate has ever been, in an upward trend since June 2017 (55%).
  - Seven programs (pp. 12-15) had consent rates below 80% (June intakes). These programs are highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during June 2018 (pp. 21-24)
  - The average LOS over all programs was 176 days (representing 1,159 exits), an increase compared to May (153 days). The increase is skewed by PSH exits averaging 1,288 days to exit, an increase of over a full year relative to May 2018. Excluding the 31 PSH projects, the average LOS was 145 days. ES and TH LOS to exit declined on average four and twelve days respectively compared to May.
  - Overall, emergency shelter and homeless outreach programs' LOS were the shortest (97 and 95 days). PSH and TH programs' LOS were longest (1288 and 268 days), as expected.
  - By County, Kauai (202 days) and Oahu (186 days) averaged the highest LOS, followed by Big Island (181 days) and Maui (135 days). The average includes PH projects, which skewthe measure.
  - Emergency Shelter LOS ranged from 77 days on Kauai to 103 days on Oahu. Positively, Maui ES LOS was down a full month compared to May.
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during June 2018 (pp. 25-30)
  - Intake Timeliness was 2.13 average days, a significant decrease compared to 3.04 average days in May. 38 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enterintakes.
  - Exit timeliness decreased to 2.27 average days compared to 2.69 days in April.
  - 45 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.
