Re: July 2018 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the July 2018 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1) End of month, July 2018 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-8)

- The Statewide census for emergency and transitional programs decreased in July 2018 (3,046) compared to June 2018 (3,140), representing a decrease in both program types for Oahu and a decrease in emergency shelter, but an increase in transitional facilities census for the Neighbor Islands.
- The total "vacant beds" compared to the HIC capacity was 421 (ES and TH) and 240 (PSH).
- 29 programs on Oahu and 14 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- Statewide active outreach clients totaled 2,080 including 1,424 on Oahu and 656 on the Neighbor Islands (an increase from June's 2,028 outreach clients). An increase for both CoCs.
- 2) Consent report for July 2018 (pp. 9-20)
 - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rates for Neighbor Islands and Oahu programs were 94% and 91% respectively; (June's rates: 96% and 93% respectively).
 - BNL: Consent to share data rates for slice as of July 2, 2018 was 93% statewide the same as the June report. Rates for July were: Oahu Families (81%) and Singles (97%). Neighbor Island family and singles rates ranged from 86% (Kauai family) to 100% (Hawaii family). (pp. 10-11).
 - For adult program intakes (n=1,036), the statewide consent to share was 94% compared to 95% in June, a significant improvement from last year's July 2017 rate (55%).
 - Five programs (pp. 12-15) had consent rates below 80% (July Intakes). These programs are highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during July 2018 (pp.21-24)
 - The average LOS over all programs was 154 days (representing 1,238 exits), a decrease compared to June (176 days). If the 14 permanent supportive housing programs exits are omitted, the average LOS was 142 days.
 - Overall, emergency shelter and homeless outreach programs' LOS were the shortest (104 and 103 days). PSH and TH program's LOS were longest (1,232 and 247 days).
 - By County, Kauai (165 days) and Hawaii (158 days) averaged the highest LOS, followed by Oahu
 and Maui (both 153 days). Of note is that the average includes PH projects, which skew the
 statistic.
 - Emergency Shelter LOS ranged from 72 days on Hawaii to 141 days on Maui.
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during July 2018 (pp. 25-29)
 - Intake Timeliness was 2.15 average days, a slight increase compared to 2.13 average days in June. 33 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enterintakes.
 - Exit timeliness decreased to 2.04 average days compared to 2.27 days in June.
 - 21 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.
