Re: September 2018 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the September 2018 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1) End of month, September 2018 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-8)

- The Statewide census for emergency and transitional programs decreased in September 2018 (2,873) compared to August 2018 (3,025) representing a decrease in the emergency and transitional census for Oahu, and a decrease in emergency shelter, but an increase in transitional facilities for the Neighbor Islands.
- The total "vacant beds" compared to the HIC bed capacity was 343 (ES and TH) and 357 (PSH). The high level for PSH is still due to the new program CCH City HF Increment III. HIC openings can also vary depending on differences in household size.
- 22 programs on Oahu and 23 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- Statewide active Outreach clients totaled 1,668 including 1,066 on Oahu and 602 on the Neighbor Islands.
- 2) Consent report for September 2018 (pp. 9-19)
 - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rates for Neighbor Islands and Oahu programs were 96% and 90% respectively; (August's rates: 97% and 90%). (page 9)
 - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of Sep 30, 2018 was 94% statewide the same rate compared to the August report. Rates for September were: Oahu Families (83%) and Singles (97%). Neighbor Island family and singles rates ranged from 81% (Kauai Families) to 99% (Hawaii and Kauai Singles). (page 10).
 - For adult program intakes entered in September 2018 (n=912), the statewide consent to share was 95%, the same rate as in August 2018, and a sustained improvement from Aug 2017 (55%).
 - Thirteen programs (pp. 11-14) had consent rates below 80% (September Intakes). These programs are highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during September 2018 (pp. 20-23)
 - The average LOS over all programs was 182 days (representing 1,070 exits), an increase compared to August (162 days). If the 35 permanent supportive housing programs exits are omitted, the average LOS was 156 days.
 - Overall, emergency shelter and homeless prevention programs' LOS were the shortest (106 and 79 days). As expected, PSH and TH program's LOS were the longest (928 and 348 days).
 - By County, Maui (111 days) and Kauai (178 days) averaged the shortest LOS, followed by Oahu (198 days) and Hawaii (199 days). Of note is that the average includes PH projects, which heavily skew this statistic.
 - Emergency Shelter LOS ranged from 101 days on Maui to 121 days on Kauai.
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during September 2018 (pp. 24-28)
 - Intake Timeliness was 2.64 average days, a slight increase compared to 2.35 average days in August. 40 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enterintakes.
 - Exit timeliness increased to 2.61 average days compared to 2.34 days in August.
 - 33 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.
