Re: November 2018 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the November 2018 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1) End of month, November 2018 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-8)

- The Statewide census for emergency and transitional programs increased in November 2018 (2,483) compared to October 2018 (2,418). For Oahu, this represents a decrease in the emergency shelter census, but an increase in transitional census. For the neighbor islands, this represents an increase in emergency shelter and transitional census.
- The total "vacant beds" compared to the HIC bed capacity was 514 (ES and TH) and 414 (PSH). The high level for PSH is due to several large projects in both Continuums being at low utilization as of the end of November. HIC openings can also vary depending on differences in household size.
- 39 programs on Oahu and 23 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- Statewide active Outreach clients totaled 1,540 (1,004 on Oahu and 536 on the Neighbor Islands).
- 2) Consent report for November 2018 (pp. 9-19)
 - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rates for Neighbor Islands and Oahu programs were 96% and 91% respectively; (October's rates: 93% and 92% respectively). (bottom page 9)
 - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of the 12/01/18 BNL cut was 98% statewide three percentage points higher than October 2018. November rates included: Oahu Families (98%) and Singles (98%). Neighbor Island family and singles rates ranged from 79% (Kauai Families) to 100% (Kauai and Maui Singles). (page 10).
 - For adult program intakes entered in November 2018 (n=820), the statewide consent to share was 97%, one percentage point higher than the October report, and a sustained improvement from Aug 2017 (55%).
 - Seven programs (pp. 11-14) had consent rates below 80% (November Intakes) highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during November 2018 (pp. 20-23)
 - The average LOS over all programs was 145 days (representing 963 exits), a decrease compared to October (186 days). If the 24 permanent supportive housing programs exits are omitted, the average LOS was 114 days.
 - Overall, homeless prevention and emergency shelter programs' LOS were the shortest (77 and 98 days). As expected, PSH and TH program's LOS were the longest (1,326 and 212 days).
 - By County, Hawaii (102 days) and Maui (140 days) averaged the shortest LOS, followed by Oahu (152 days) and Kauai (177 days). Of note is that the average includes PH projects, which heavily skew this statistic.
 - Emergency Shelter LOS ranged from 66 days on Hawaii to 100 days on Maui and Oahu.
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during November 2018 (pp. 24-28)
 - Intake Timeliness was 2.69 average days, a slight decrease compared to 2.79 average days in October. 37 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enterintakes.
 - Exit timeliness increased to 2.75 average days compared to 2.24 days in October.
 - 48 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.
