Re: December 2018 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the December 2018 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1) End of month, December 2018 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-8)

- The Statewide census for emergency and transitional programs increased in December 2018 (2,492) compared to November 2018 (2,483). For Oahu, this represents an increase in the emergency shelter and transitional census. For the neighbor islands, this represents a decrease in emergency shelter and transitional census.
- The total "vacant beds" compared to the HIC bed capacity was 491 (ES and TH) and 408 (PSH). This is a slight decrease from last month when it was also noted that several large projects in both Continuums had low utilization. HIC openings can also vary depending on differences in household size.
- 37 programs on Oahu and 24 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- Statewide active Outreach clients totaled 1,601 (1,087 on Oahu and 514 on the Neighbor Islands).
- 2) Consent report for December 2018 (pp. 9-20)
 - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rates for Neighbor Islands and Oahu programs were 93% and 89% respectively; (November's rates: 96% and 91% respectively). (bottom page 9)
 - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of the 1/05/19, BNL cut was 96% statewide two percentage points lower than November 2018. December rates included: Oahu Families (93%) and Singles (99%). Neighbor Island family and singles rates ranged from 72% (Kauai Families) to 100% (Kauai and Maui Singles). (page 10).
 - For adult program intakes entered in December 2018 (n=699), the statewide consent to share was 96%, one percentage point lower than the November report, and a sustained improvement since August 2017 (55%).
 - Four programs (pp. 11-14) had consent rates below 80% (December Intakes) highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during December 2018 (pp. 21-24)
 - The average LOS over all programs was 182 days (representing 963 exits), an increase compared to November (145 days). If the 23 permanent supportive housing programs exits are omitted, the average LOS was 153 days.
 - Overall, homeless prevention and outreach programs' LOS were the shortest (89 and 85 days). As expected, PSH and TH program's LOS were the longest (1,467 and 267 days).
 - By County, Kauai (159 days) and Oahu (175 days) averaged the shortest LOS, followed by Hawaii (186 days) and Maui (202 days). Of note is that the average includes PH projects, which heavily skew this statistic.
 - Emergency Shelter LOS was higher than previous months and ranged from 94 days on Oahu to 205 days on Kauai. November's LOS ranged from 66 days (Hawaii) to 100 days (Oahu and Maui).
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during December 2018 (pp. 25-30)
 - Intake Timeliness was 2.57 average days, a slight decrease compared to 2.69 average days in November. 27 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enterintakes.
 - Exit timeliness increased to 4.03 average days compared to 2.74 days in November.
 - 45 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.
