Re: October 2019 HMIS Monitoring Reports (Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap)

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Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the October 2019 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1. End of month, October 2019 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-5)
  - The Neighbor Island census for emergency shelter (ES) and transitional housing (TH) programs increased in October 2019 (667), compared to September 2019 (643), with an increase in both programs.
  - The total “vacant beds” compared to the HIC bed capacity was 234 (ES and TH) and 180 (permanent supportive housing – PSH). This is an increase for ES and TH, and a decrease for PSH compared to last month. HIC openings can also vary depending on differences in household size.
  - 31 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
  - Active outreach clients totaled 398, a decrease compared to September 2019 (426 clients).
2. Consent report for October 2019 (pp. 6-13)
  - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rate for Neighbor Islands was 98%, one percentage point lower than in September.
  - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of the 11/02/19, BNL cut was 99% for the CoC. October rates included: 100% for Singles/Families on Kauai, and for singles on Maui and Hawaii; 99% for Maui Families, and 91% for Hawaii Families.
  - For adult program intakes entered in October 2019 (n=320), the Neighbor Islands consent to share data rate was 97%, two percentage points higher than in September 2019.
  - One program had a consent rate below 80% (October Intakes) - highlighted in RED.
3. Length of stay (LOS) by agency and program for clients exiting during October 2019 (pp. 14-15)
  - The average LOS over all programs was 138 days (representing 427 exits), a slight increase compared to September 2019 (135 days). Of note is that four clients in PSH programs had very short LOS (three client records show no days, and one client record shows 43 days).
  - The average LOS for Neighbors Islands in October (138 days) was less than the statewide average LOS for all months from January through August 2019, which ranged from 143 days in July to 244 days in March 2019.
  - Excluding PSH, ES and street outreach programs’ LOS were the shortest (94 and 91 days). RRH and services only programs’ lengths of stay were the longest (224 and 204 days).
  - By County, Hawaii (168 days) averaged the longest LOS, followed by Kauai (117 days) and Maui (114 days).
  - Emergency shelter average LOS ranged from 89 days on Maui to 116 days on Kauai.
  - Transitional housing average LOS ranged from 110 days on Maui to 731 days on Hawaii.
4. Timeliness (entries and exits) during October 2019 (pp. 16-17)
  - Intake timeliness was 2.18 average days, a decrease compared to 2.81 average days in September.
  - 19 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter intakes.
  - Exit timeliness decreased to 2.14 average days compared to 2.27 average days in September.
  - 11 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.

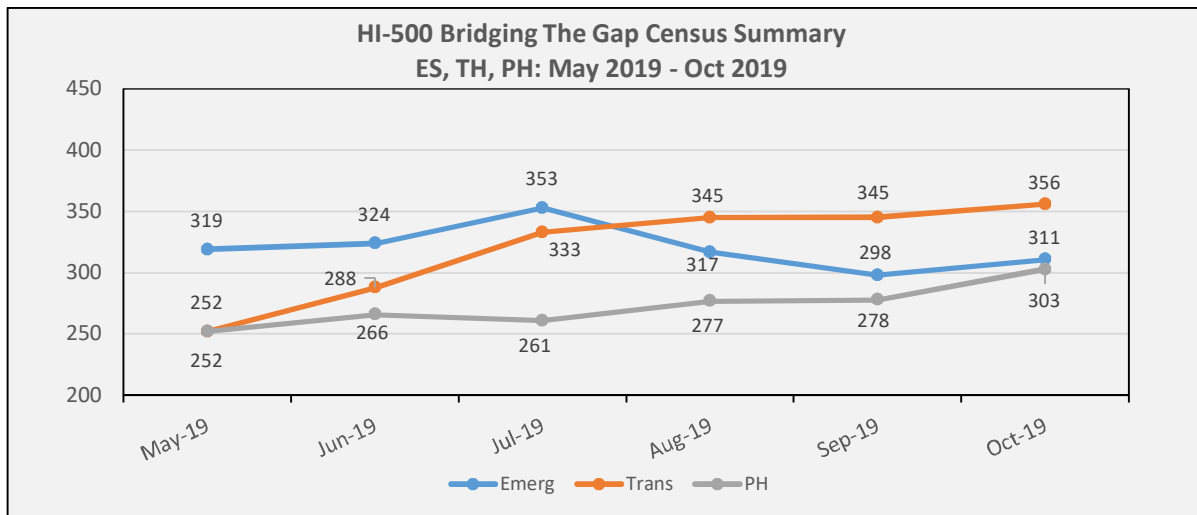

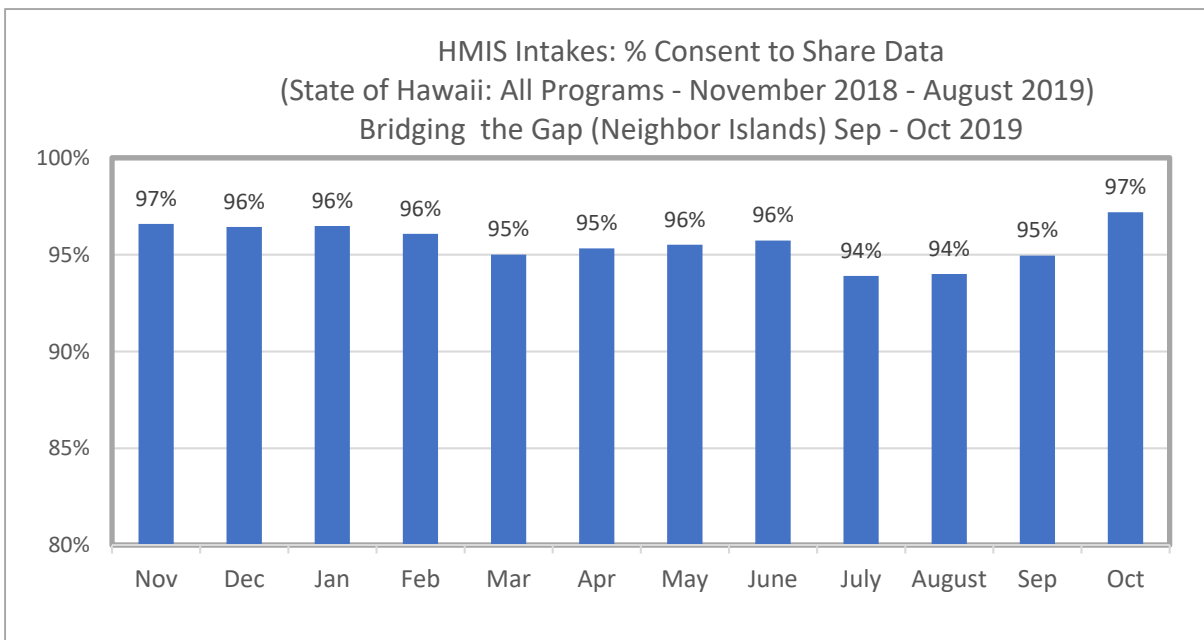
