Re: December 2019 HMIS Monitoring Reports (Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap)

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the December 2019 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1. End of month, December 2019 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-5)

- The Neighbor Island census for emergency shelter (ES) and transitional housing (TH) programs decreased in December 2019 (641), compared to November 2019 (653), with a decrease in both ES and TH programs.
- The total "vacant beds" compared to the HIC bed capacity was 228 (ES and TH) and 133 (permanent supportive housing PSH). This is an increase for ES and TH, but a decrease for PSH compared to last month. HIC openings can also vary depending on differences in household size.
- 22 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- Active outreach clients totaled 398, a slight increase compared to November 2019 (394 clients).
- 2. Consent report for December 2019 (pp. 6-12)
 - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rate for Neighbor Islands was 98%, a two-percentage point increase compared to November.
 - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of the 1/02/20, BNL cut was 98% for the CoC. December rates included: 100% for Kauai singles; 99% for Maui families and singles and Hawaii singles; 90% for Kauai Families, and 86% for Hawaii Families.
 - For adult program intakes entered in December 2019 (n=269), the Neighbor Islands consent to share data rate was 99%, two percentage points higher than in November 2019.
 - One program had a consent rate below 80% (December Intakes) highlighted in RED.
- 3. Length of stay (LOS) by agency and program for clients exiting during December 2019 (pp. 13-15)
 - The average LOS over all programs was 134 days (representing 402 exits), an increase compared to November 2019 (109 days).
 - The average LOS for Neighbors Islands in December (134 days) was less than the statewide average LOS for all months from January through August 2019, which ranged from 143 days in July to 244 days in March 2019.
 - Excluding PSH, the average LOS was 133 days. ES and street outreach programs' LOS were the shortest (74 and 106 days). PSH and TH programs' lengths of stay were the longest (306 and 192 days).
 - By County, Kauai (179 days) averaged the longest LOS, followed by Hawaii (135 days) and Maui (126 days).
 - Emergency shelter average LOS ranged from 69 days on Maui to 198 days on Kauai.
 - Transitional housing average LOS ranged from 122 days on Maui to 390 days on Hawaii.
- 4. Timeliness (entries and exits) during December 2019 (pp. 16-17)
 - Intake timeliness was 2.11 average days, a decrease compared to 2.71 average days in November.
 - 10 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter intakes.
 - Exit timeliness decreased to 1.9 average days, an increase compared to 1.5 average days in November.
 - 11 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.




