Re: January 2020 HMIS Monitoring Reports (Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap)

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the January 2020 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1. End of month, January 2020 Census summary (pp. 2-4)

- The Neighbor Island census for emergency shelter (ES) and transitional housing (TH) programs decreased in January 2020 (635), compared to December 2019 (641), with an increase in ES, but a decrease in TH programs.
- The total "vacant beds" compared to the HIC bed capacity was 172 (ES and TH) and 143 (permanent supportive housing PSH). This is a decrease for ES and TH, but an increase for PSH compared to last month. HIC openings can also vary depending on differences in household size.
- 20 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- Active outreach clients totaled 384, a decrease compared to December 2019 (398 clients).
- 2. Consent report for January 2020 (pp. 5-11)
 - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rate for Neighbor Islands was 99%, a one-percentage point increase compared to December.
 - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of the 2/01/20, BNL cut was 97% for the CoC. January rates included: 100% for Kauai singles; 99% for Maui families and singles; 98% for Hawaii singles; 90% for Kauai Families, and 86% for Hawaii Families.
 - For adult program intakes entered in January 2020 (n=290), the Neighbor Islands consent to share data rate was 98%, one percentage point lower than in December 2019.
 - No programs had a consent rate below 80%.
- 3. Length of stay (LOS) by agency and program for clients exiting during January 2020 (pp. 12-14)
 - The average LOS over all programs was 140 days (representing 422 exits), an increase compared to December 2019 (134 days).
 - The average LOS for Neighbors Islands in January (140 days) was less than the statewide average LOS for all months from January through August 2019 (181 days), but above the average LOS for Neighbor Island programs from September 2019 January 2020 (131 days).
 - Excluding PSH, the average LOS was 116 days. ES and street outreach programs' LOS were the shortest (92 and 91 days). PSH and TH programs' lengths of stay were the longest (1,561 and 193 days).
 - By County, Kauai (283 days) averaged the longest LOS, followed by Hawaii and Maui (124 days).
 - Emergency shelter average LOS ranged from 70 days on Hawaii to 174 days on Kauai.
 - Transitional housing average LOS ranged from 123 days on Maui to 465 days on Hawaii.
- 4. Timeliness (entries and exits) during January 2020 (pp. 15-16)
 - Intake timeliness was 1.74 average days, a decrease compared to 2.11 average days in December.
 - 14 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter intakes.
 - Exit timeliness decreased to 1.25 average days, a decrease compared to 1.9 average days in December.
 - 8 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.




